Concern for the environment is equal to other management responsibilities and business targets and to that end, as we seek to continually develop and improve company capacity, we will also endeavour to continually improve environmental performance by establishing, monitoring and reviewing our objectives regularly to address the environmental risks and opportunities associated with our operations.


